This Week's Meeting

Our guest speaker will be Professor James Vickers, Director of the Wicking Dementia Centre at the University of Tasmania.

The Wicking Dementia Centre has research programs that relate to the cause, prevention and care of people with dementia. The Centre is also the leading global provider of dementia education. The presentation will about how the Centres' educational initiatives have reached just about every country in the world, and how these may serve as interventions to improve the care of people with dementia, and also as important tools to lead public health initiatives to help people build self-efficacy in reducing their risk of dementia. Professor Vickers wishes to introduce a new research project focussed on Tasmania that will be the biggest research trial ever undertaken on reducing risk of dementia at the population level.
