We were treated to a very interesting and, in parts, confidential briefing on the Tasmanian salmon industry and the very important developments taking place in technology and expansion by Tassal and other participants by Ben Daley, Head of Supply Chain at Tassal, Tassal has grown to a turnover of \$500m and represents 50% of the annual Tasmanian output of 60000 tonnes. They have developed a state of the art feed control system in Hobart's Marine Board Building servicing their 4 farms around the State and are planning expansion into prawn farming on the mainland. All told the salmon industry farms occupy just 2300 hectares of coastal waters. Tassal alone has 1300 employees.

Strollers (Athol Wilkes 62241673)


