REPORT ON JUNE MEETING





New members Rob McShane and Nick Mason were inducted into the Club by President Brian and then gave members details of their careers and interests.

Graham Sargison introduced ABC cameraman Peter Curtis, for whom photography has been a family tradition, as our guest speaker. Peter gave the Club a very entertaining review of his career which began in Hobart straight out of school in 1984. As a 24 year old he began working in ABC overseas stations including periods as bureau cameraman in Moscow (with Monica Attard), the Middle East and Washington. He has also made eight visits to Antarctica where he has filmed important pieces for national broadcasts. Peter described the evolution of cameras and other equipment in his time at the ABC and proudly showed us work done for Landline ... Saltwater Muster on Robbins Island.

Peter outlined the contraction of ABC staffing in Tasmania that resulted, in part, from the loss of national programs Landline and The Collectors and the increased mobility of cameramen around the country as reports on major events such as the recent floods require more manpower.

Today's Business....

Our July guest speaker is Roger McNeice whose talk is entitled "Bushfire Disasters in Tasmania".

Roger McNeice was involved with the Taroona Rural fire brigade from 1968 until 1985. In 1972 he was appointed captain of the brigade and, in 1982, when the brigade became a dual purpose brigade under the operational control of the Hobart Fire Brigade, he was appointed first officer, a position he held until 1984. In 1979 He was awarded a Certificate of Merit from the Kingborough Municipality for service to the community and an Australian National Medal for service in 1985. He was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia in 1996. In 1983 he was awarded a Churchill fellowship in his capacity as Honorary Numismatist for the Tasmanian Museum and Art Gallery and in 2004 Life Membership of the Tasmanian

Churchill Fellows Association. He has written 5 books on the history of fire-fighting in Tasmania and is an internationally recognised numismatist and has published several books on numismatics.
