
IPhone Settings



Aeroplane Mode – stops your device sending and receiving calls and text messages (also known as flight mode).

Wi-Fi – tells you which network you're connected to plus all the networks within range. If there's a padlock icon next to it, it means you need the password.

Bluetooth – allows you to connect Bluetooth device (speaker, Airpods, CarPlay, keyboard, mouse ...)

Mobile data – this allows you to turn on/off mobile data

Personal hotspot – provides internet access to other devices.

You'll need a password and if others want to join your personal hotspot they will need the password.

If you swipe down from the top-right corner of your screen, you'll be able to access this menu.
